AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE
LABOR COUNCIL (POLICE OFFICERS UNIT) AND
THE MCHENRY COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT REGARDING A TEN (10) HOUR
SCHEDULE TRIAL

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the McHenry County Conservation District (hereinafter referred to as the "District") desires to execute a request to a trial ten hour schedule to as per the Labor Agreement with the Fraternal Order of Police Labor Council (hereinafter referred to as the "Labor Council") through March 30, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, the current labor agreement with the Labor Council expires on March 31, 2020 was approved through Ordinance #17-927 on March 27, 2017; and,

WHEREAS, the current agreement called included consideration of a trial ten (10) hour schedule; and




WHEREAS, both parties have reached agreement and a copy of said Memorandum of Understanding is attached to this Resolution as "Exhibit A".
