

MCHENRY COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT
RESOLUTION #19-66

AUTHORIZING THE PLACEMENT OF THE HOUSE AT 20302 US HIGHWAY 14,
HARAVARD, IL WHICH IS PART OF THE RUSH CREEK CONSERVATION AREA
ON THE DISTRICT'S DEMOLITION LIST AND TO
AUTHORIZE THE REMOVAL OF THE STRUCTURE WHEN RESOURCES ALLOW

WHEREAS, the McHenry County Conservation District (hereinafter referred to as the "DISTRICT"), is authorized to acquire and hold lands for Conservation District Act purposes as set forth in the Conservation District Act (70 ILCS 410, et. seq.); and

WHEREAS, the District is a unit of government authorized by the Illinois Constitution (Il Const. Art VII §10); and

WHEREAS, the District is authorized to manage and use such real property in such manner and with such restrictions as will leave it unimpaired for the benefit of future generations; and

WHEREAS, the District has determined that it is in the best interest of the District and the benefit of future generations to remove certain buildings and structures that are not needed to carry out the District's mission; and

WHEREAS, after assessment it has been determined that it is in the best interest of the District to place the house at 20302 US Highway 14 in Harvard, IL which is part of the Rush Creek Conservation Area on the demolition list; and

WHEREAS, a timeline for the demolition has not been identified and will dependent of staffing and financial resources available and appropriated; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees, the Executive Director is hereby authorized to place the house at 2032 US Highway 14 in Harvard, IL on the demolition list and to move forward in removing the structure as financial resources are allowed and as appropriated for in the District's annual budget.
