

## 2020 Hunting Program – at a glance

Zone maps are available on MCCD website if you need to see where the hunters will be on District property.

### Archery

Orientation meeting – Sept. 3 (Can scout and set up stands starting Sept. 4)

*All these hunting areas are on District property that is not open to the public*

#### Full Season: October 1 – January 17

**Alden Sedge Meadow:** number of zones not to exceed three (3). Number of adult hunters not to exceed nine (9).

**Coral Woods:** number of zones not to exceed one (1). Number of adult hunters not to exceed three (3).

**High Point:** number of zones not to exceed one (1). Number of adult hunters not to exceed three (3).

**Hollows:** number of zones not to exceed one (1). Number of adult hunters not to exceed three (3).

**HUM-Diekman/formerly Kloempken:** number of zones not to exceed two (2). Number of adult hunters not to exceed six (6).

**Lake Elizabeth:** number of zones not to exceed one (1). Number of adult hunters not to exceed three (3).

**Marengo Ridge:** number of zones not to exceed four (4). Number of adult hunters not to exceed twelve (12).

**Pioneer Fen:** number of zones not to exceed one (1). Number of adult hunters not to exceed three (3).

**Pleasant Valley:** number of zones not to exceed four (4). Number of adult hunters not to exceed twelve (12).

**Queen Anne Prairie:** number of zones not to exceed five (5). Number of adult hunters not to exceed fifteen (15).

**Rush Creek:** number of zones not to exceed four (4). Number of adult hunters not to exceed twelve (12).

**Silver Creek:** number of zones not to exceed two (2). Number of adult hunters not to exceed six (6).

**Stickney Run - Indian Ridge:** number of zones not to exceed one (1). Number of adult hunters not to exceed three (3).

**Stickney Run South:** number of zones not to exceed one (1). Number of adult hunters not to exceed three (3).

**Winding Creek:** number of zones not to exceed three (3). Number of adult hunters not to exceed nine (9).

#### Late Season: November 1 - January 17

**Fel-Pro West Entrance:** number of zones not to exceed one (1). Number of adult hunters not to exceed three (3).

**High Point:** number of zones not to exceed two (2). Number of adult hunters not to exceed six (6).

**Fox Bluff:** number of zones not to exceed four (4). Number of adult hunters not to exceed twelve (12).

**Winding Creek:** number of zones not to exceed one (1). Number of hunters not to exceed three (3).

9-day Special Season Eastside Program: Oct 2-4, Oct 30-Nov 1, Nov 6-8

**Hickory Grove:** number of zones not to exceed three (3). Number of adult hunters not to exceed nine (9).

**Hollows:** number of zones not to exceed three (3). Number of adult hunters not to exceed nine (9).

**Lyons Prairie:** number of zones not to exceed three (3). Number of adult hunters not to exceed nine (9).

**Silver Creek:** number of zones not to exceed five (5). Number of adult hunters not to exceed fifteen (15).

**Stickney Run North:** number of zones not to exceed three (3). Number of adult hunters not to exceed nine (9).

**Combination Archery and Firearm Deer Hunt**

Combo Archery/ Firearms deer hunt: Full Season October 1-January 17, Late Season November 1 - January 17 (Including muzzleloader and late CWD firearm seasons: December 11-13, December 31-January 3, and January 15-17, 2021 only.) No hunting or scouting is permitted during the regular first or second firearm seasons, except for Glacial Park combo, which will be allowed to participate in the first firearm season November 20-22. Combo hunters participating in the first firearm season at Glacial Park hunt will be required to follow the check in procedure for firearm hunters.

Full Season: October 1 – January 17

**Brookdale – Paulson, Bunker Hill, Brookdale and Deep Cut Roads:** number of zones not to exceed five (5). Number of adult hunters not to exceed fifteen (15).

**Kishwaukee Corridor:** number of zones not to exceed nine (9). Number of adult hunters not to exceed twenty seven (24).

**Coral Woods:** number of zones not to exceed four (4). Number of adult hunters not to exceed twelve (12).

Late Season: November 1 - January 17

**Brookdale - Deep Cut Road:** number of zones not to exceed two (2). Number of adult hunters not to exceed six (6).

**Glacial Park:** number of zones not to exceed four (4). Number of adult hunters not to exceed twelve (12).

First Season – November 20-22

**Glacial Park:** Number of zones not to exceed thirty-two (32). Number of hunters not to exceed 64. Please note: (the hunter may need to supply his/her own free-standing elevated stand or rent one from the District.) Please reference zone map and indicate on application if preference for free-standing grassland zone. The District has ten free-standing tripods for a \$50 rental fee.

Second Season –December 3-6

**Marengo Ridge:** Number of zones not to exceed ten (10). Number of hunters not to exceed twenty (20).

**Rush Creek:** Number of zones not to exceed ten (10). Number of hunters not to exceed 20.

Marsh Only: Reserve Hunt Participants

Reserve Hunting is allowed weekly from opening weekend through December 14. (Fri., Sat., Sun and Mon. of each week.)

Week 1: **October 16-19**

Week 2: October 23-26

Week 3: October 30-November 2

Week 4: November 13-16

Week 5: November 20-23 (No Hunting at Glacial Park)

Week 6: November 27-30

Week 7: December 4-7

Week 8: December 11-14

**Glacial Park - Pickerel Creek-Marsh:** One (1) blind allowing one group per week.

**Hebron Peatlands:** Two (2) blinds allowing two (2) groups per week.

Marsh Open: Marsh Only Reserved or Combo Hunt Participants

Marsh hunting is allowed weekly from opening day through the end of the IDNR established waterfowl seasons.

**Kishwaukee Corridor Quarry-Route 20:** One (1) blind

**Pleasant Valley-Hemmingsen Road:** One (1) zone; no blind

**Queen Anne Pond-Queen Anne Road:** One (1) blind

### Field Hunting: Field Only or Combo Hunt Participants

Field Hunting will begin after crops are removed from the field at each site. Please check the website to make sure the crops are out at a certain site before going afield. A field hunting site is not legally accessible until it is **officially designated as “open” on the District website**. Below are the potential locations for open hunts, final determinations on which sites will be open for the season will be made prior to the orientation meeting.

Field Hunting will extend to the goose season end date in January set by IDNR. At the time of this directive, the tentative season end date is January 14, 2021.

#### **Kishwaukee Corridor Field - Ballard Road** (formerly Lussy Parcel)

-number of zones not to exceed two (2)

#### **Kishwaukee Corridor –Burma Road**

#### **Kishwaukee Corridor - River Road**

-number of zones not to exceed one (1)

#### **Kishwaukee Corridor - County Line Road**

-number of zones not to exceed one (1)

#### **Pleasant Valley - Hemmingsen Road**

-number of zones not to exceed two (2)

#### **Queen Anne Field - Queen Anne Road**

-number of zones not to exceed three (3)

### Waterfowl Youth Hunt

The youth hunt is scheduled for **October 10th and 11th** (Sat. and Sun.)

**Glacial Park / Pickerel Creek Marsh:** one (1) blind allowing up to two youth hunters.

**Hebron Peatlands:** two (2) blinds allowing up to four youth hunters.

**Kishwaukee Corridor Quarry - Route 20:** one (1) blind allowing up to two youth hunters.

**Pleasant Valley - Hemmingsen Road:** one zone allowing up to two youth hunters.

**Queen Anne – Queen Anne Road:** one (1) blind allowing up to two youth hunters.

### Spring Turkey Youth Hunt

The youth hunt is scheduled for the IL Youth Spring Turkey seasons March 27 and 28, 2021 and April 3 and 4, 2021 (dates are tentative, final dates dependent on IL youth seasons).
