RESOLUTION #16-25

AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE MCHENRY COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT AND
VILLAGE OF CARY
TO PROVIDE MUTUAL AID

WHEREAS, the McHenry County Conservation District (hereinafter referred to as the "District") and the Village of Cary (hereinafter referred to as the "Village") are units of local government authorized by the Illinois Constitution (Il Const. Art VII §10) and the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5 ILCS 220/1 et seq. [1999]) to contract with each other and otherwise agree amongst themselves and undertake certain transactions with each other; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have determined that it is in the best interest of each to enter into an agreement to provide for mutual and joint law enforcement procedures and assistance for both the District and the Village; and

WHEREAS, so as to memorialize their mutual understanding, agreement, and commitment to such an agreement, the District and the Village are prepared to enter into a certain Mutual Aid Agreement setting forth their mutual understanding and agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of the McHenry County Conservation District that the President and Secretary thereof are hereby authorized to adopt the resolution and accept the Mutual Aid Agreement with the Village of Cary until terminated by either party.
