RESOLUTION OF PROCLAMATION

DECLARING JUNE 21-29, 2018
AS MCHENRY COUNTY BICYCLE WEEK 2018




WHEREAS, the Conservation District endeavors to promote safe and responsible bicycling in McHenry County.






