A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MCHENRY COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS FOR THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES (IDNR) FOR A FEDERAL RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM (RTP) GRANT TO FUND THE TRAIL CONNECTION AT LANGE ROAD NEAR HEBRON, ILLINOIS ALONG THE HEBRON TRAIL

**WHEREAS**, the McHenry County Conservation District (hereinafter referred to as the "District"), is authorized to acquire and hold lands for Conservation District Act purposes as set forth in the Conservation District Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the District protects and preserves wildland not under cultivation or otherwise subject to intensive use or development; and

**WHEREAS**, the District has plans to connect two portions of the Hebron Trail near Hebron, Illinois at Lange Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Department of Natural Resources is accepting applications for the Federal Recreational Trail Program (RTP) for grant to aid in the development and repair of trail infrastructure.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the McHenry County Conservation District Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the Executive Director or her designee to execute all documents necessary and to submit an application for an Illinois Department of Natural Resources Federal Recreational Trail Program grant for connecting the two portions of the Hebron Trail at Lange Road near Hebron, Illinois as per the terms of the grant application.



RE: Resolution #20-04 - Authorizing the Submission of an Illinois Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) Federal Recreational Trails Program (RTP) Application for Linking the east and west segments of the Hebron Trail near Lange Road in rural Hebron Township

### SUMMARY:

Staff is seeking authorization to submit a grant application to the Illinois Department of Natural Resources (IDNR), Federal Recreational Trails Program (RTP) application for linking the east and west segments of the Hebron Trail near Lange Road in rural Hebron Township. The grant, if awarded, pays up to eighty percent (80%) of the project funding. The remaining twenty percent (20%) will be at the District's cost. The project's preliminary cost projection is \$210,000. Twenty percent (20%) of that is \$42,000.

The Federal Recreational Trails Program (RTP) was created through the National Recreational Trail Fund Act established in 1991. Applications must be completed and submitted to IDNR by March 2, 2020, 5:00 pm.
