

**MCHENRY COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT
RESOLUTION #20-102**

AUTHORIZING THE AMENDING OF RESOLUTION #20-67 AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF THREE (3) REPLACEMENT VEHICLES DIRECTLY OFF OF THE ILLINOIS STATE BID PURCHASING CONTRACT #18-146CMS-BOSS4-P-246 FOR AN ADDITIONAL \$7,000, FOR A TOTAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$97,000

WHEREAS, the McHenry County Conservation District (hereinafter referred to as the "District"), is a conservation district organized and existing under the laws of the State of Illinois (70 ILCS 410); and

WHEREAS, the District's approved FY 2021 Budget supports purchasing three (3) vehicles as part of the District's vehicle replacement program which rotates out vehicles that reach the end of their dependable use; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of these vehicles, which typically take place in April or May, was delayed, due to the District's financial concerns related to the COVID19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the approval to purchase was granted in August; and

WHEREAS, the District was notified near the end of October that the 2021 vehicles that met District specs were available to order; and

WHEREAS, the base price for the 2021 vehicles increase by approximately \$2,000 per vehicle, thus increasing the purchase price to an estimated combined total of \$97,000; and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois Procurement Office conducted the required bid process for vehicles for purchase and available to the District through the Joint Purchasing Agreement for the items as specified and sought within the approved FY 2021 budget; and

WHEREAS, the District is empowered to enter into contracts and take such other actions as may be necessary for the proper conduct of its affairs (70 ILCS 410/12); and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have determined that it is in the best interest of the District and the public for the entities to cooperatively coordinate the implementation of the purchase as outlined in the contract as presented to the Board and which is attached and made a part of the related project Bid files.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of the District that it is necessary, desirable, and in the best interest of the District to execute the Contract, and the President and Secretary of the Board of Trustees are hereby authorized to execute this resolution and the Executive Director or her designee is authorized to execute said Contract and other necessary documents to execute the intent of this resolution.
