RECOGNIZING SERGEANT WOLFE AND OFFICER BUKOVSKY  
WITH A LIFE SAVING AWARD

WHEREAS, the McHenry County Conservation District (hereinafter referred to as the "District"), is a conservation district organized and existing under the laws of the State of Illinois (70 ILCS 410); and

WHEREAS, the District is authorized to employ police officers to enforce any rule or regulation provided by District ordinances and laws of any authority for which they are certified; and,

WHEREAS, the District has entered into Mutual Aid agreements with several local policing agencies including the McHenry County Sheriff's Department; and

WHEREAS, on May 30, 2020, Sergeant Ben Wolfe and Officer Ryan Bukovsky provided assistance to the McHenry County Sheriff's Office by using a thermal imaging tool to locate an armed subject and were able to negotiate a peaceful resolution without the loss of life.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of the District that it is desirable to recognize the life saving work and contributions of Sergeant Wolfe and Officer Bukovsky at this time; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the President and Secretary of the Board of Trustees are hereby authorized to execute this resolution and the Executive Director is authorized to execute other necessary documents to execute the intent of this resolution.




