

MCHENRY COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT
RESOLUTION #21-32

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO SUBMIT AN ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES (IDNR) LOCAL GOVERNMENT SNOWMOBILE GRANT TO PROVIDE THE MCHENRY COUNTY SNOWMOBILE ASSOCIATION WITH \$40,000 TO MAINTAIN SNOWMOBILE TRAILS THROUGHOUT THE COUNTY FOR A 3-YEAR PERIOD (2021, 2022, 2023)

WHEREAS, the McHenry County Conservation District (hereinafter referred to as the "District"), is authorized to acquire and hold lands for Conservation District Act purposes as set forth in the Conservation District Act; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Department of Natural Resources (hereinafter referred to as "IDNR") had funds available under the Snowmobile Grant Projects Program; and

WHEREAS, for the past thirteen winters, the McHenry County Snowmobile Association (hereinafter referred to as "Association") has used grants obtained by the District through the Local Government Snowmobile Grant Program to groom and maintain the 225-mile network of McHenry County snowmobile trails; and

WHEREAS, the Association has asked the District to once again submit a grant to help pay for tractor rental costs and operation & maintenance expenses involved in keeping the snowmobile trails well-groomed and safe; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the McHenry County Conservation District Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the Executive Director or her designee to execute all documents necessary and to submit an application for an Illinois Department of Natural Resources Snowmobile Grant Projects Program for the grooming of snowmobile trails in McHenry County as per the terms of the grant application.




